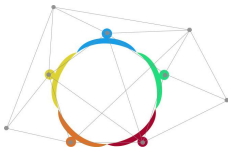


1. INTRODUCTION

The first part of the page shows a carousel of some emotional pictures that are related to the Do It Together Approach.

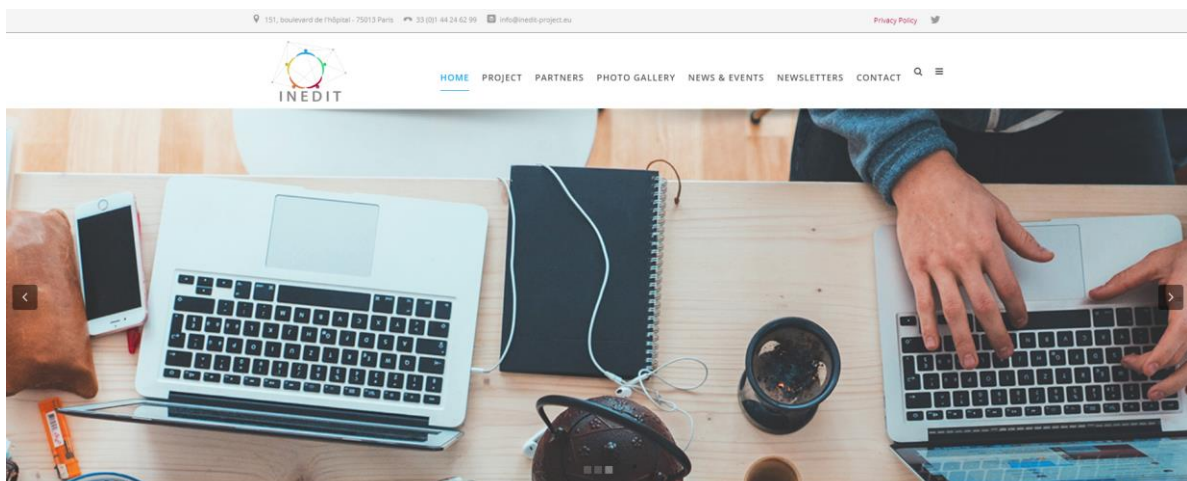
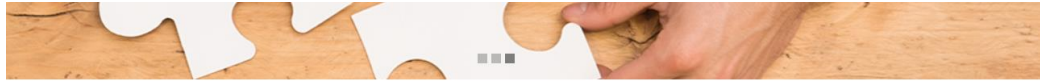
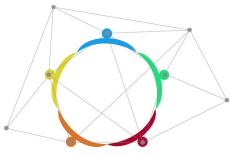


Figure 1: Home Page Slider

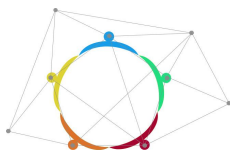

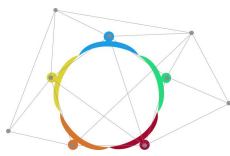
Figure 4: Home Page, Recent News and Twitter posts

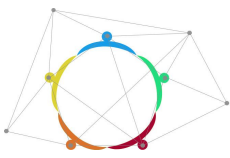

The “Project” page is accessible from both the Menu bar on the top of each page and the link “Learn more on INEDIT” that follows the brief description of the project in the Home Page.

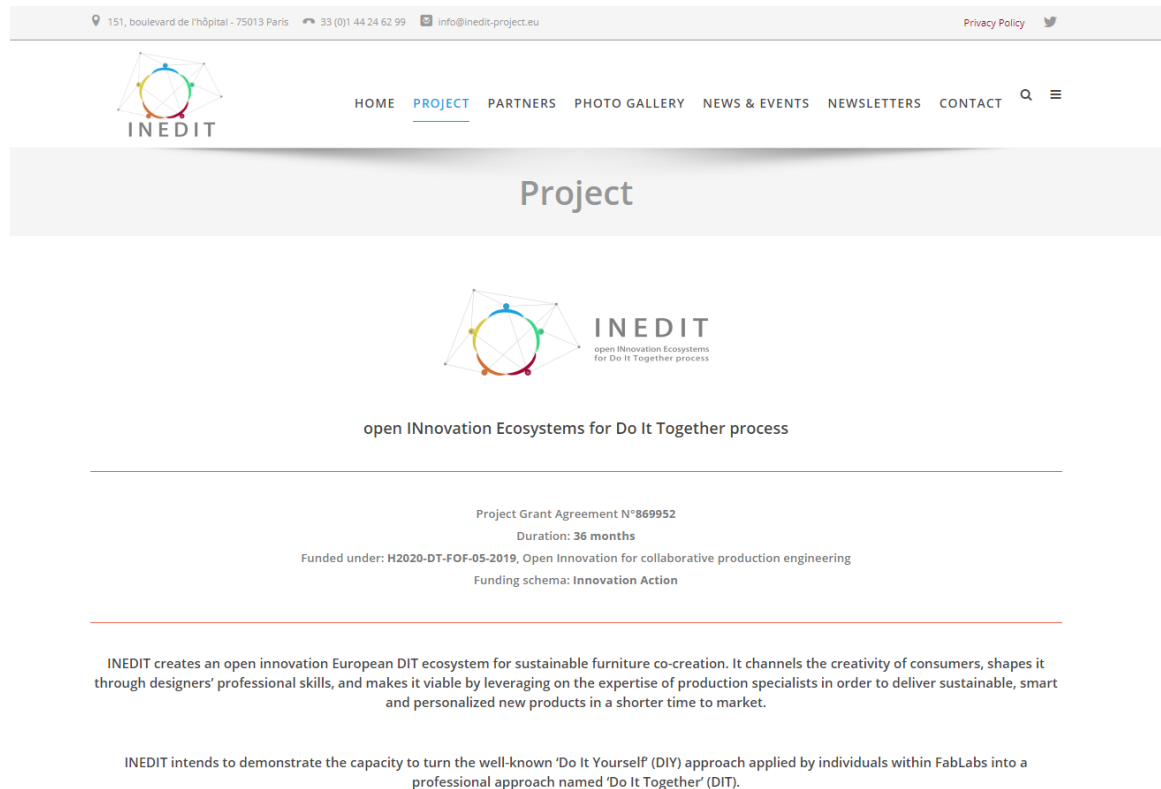


Figure 8: Project Page, INEDIT Description

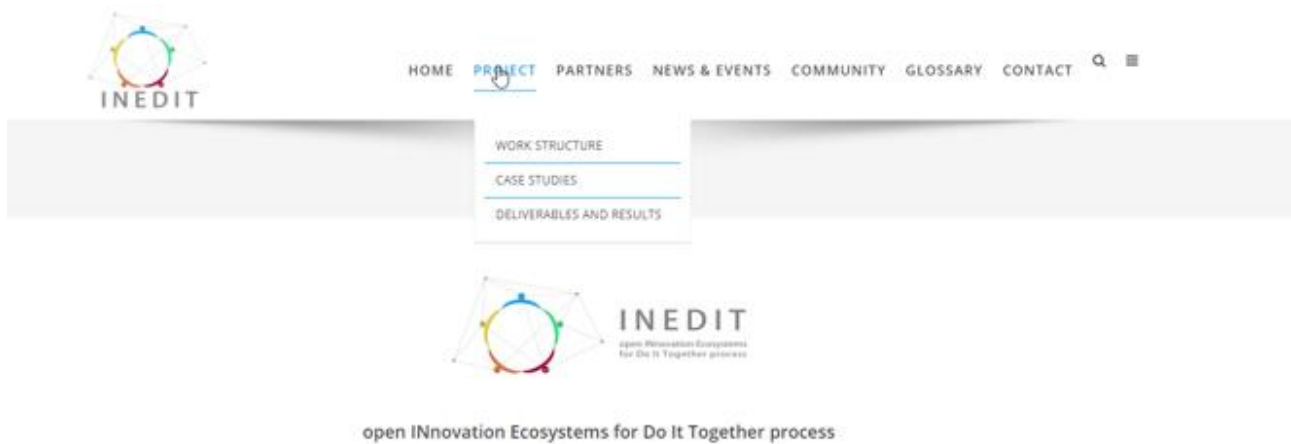
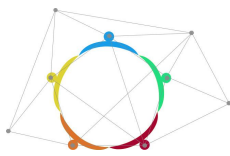


Figure 9: Project drop-down menu

The page is dedicated to the description of the Work Breakdown Structure of the project. The eight Work Packages and the relative objectives are listed.

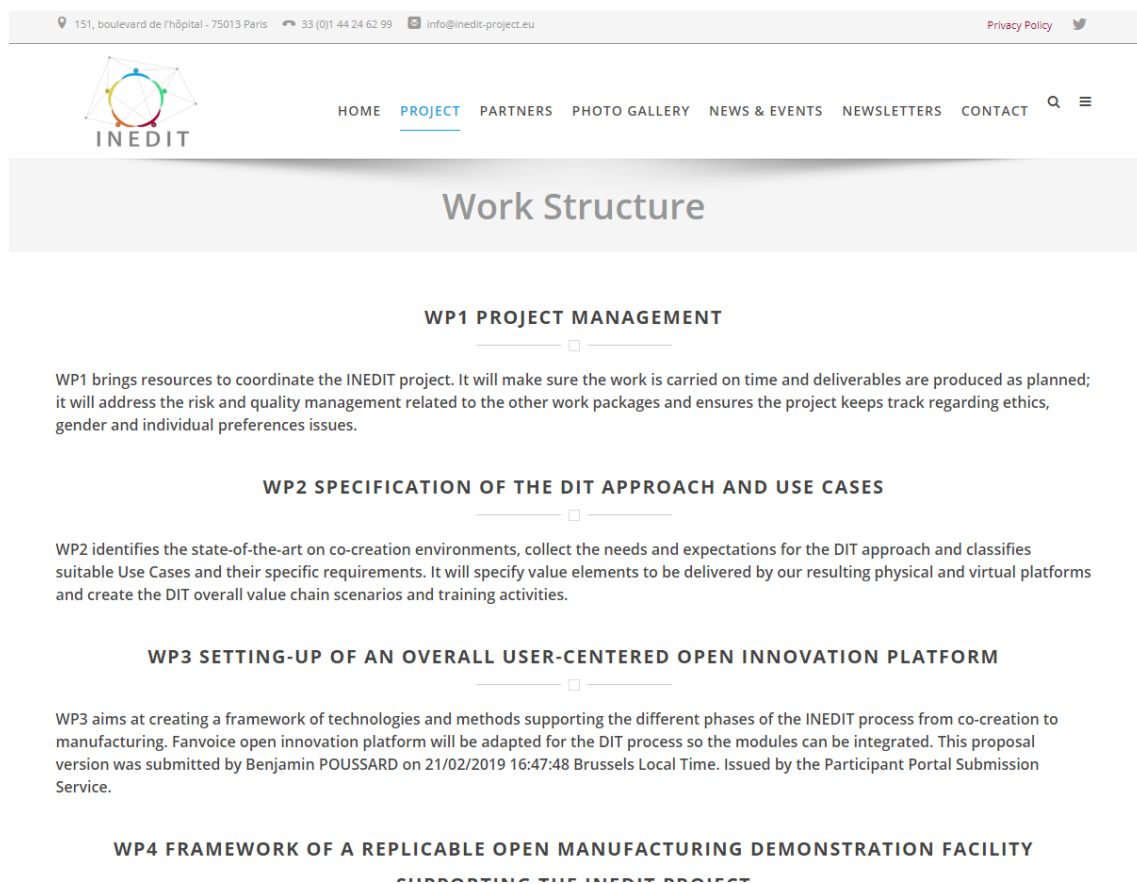
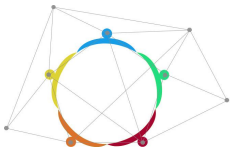


Figure 10: Work Structure Page

INEDIT has selected four valuable use cases for a DIT approach, each one pushing further the capabilities of the DIT approach, addressing individual preferences and accessibility to production means.





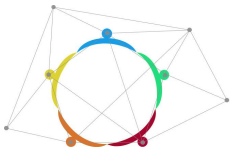

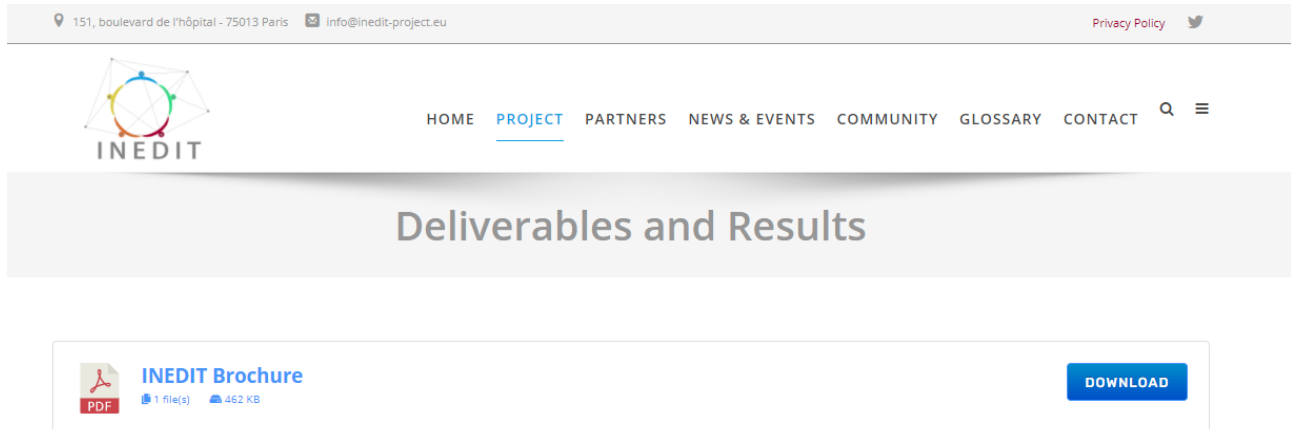


Figure 12 : Deliverables and Results page (under construction)

This page is accessible from the Menu bar on the top of each page. A grid with the logos of each project partner is shown.

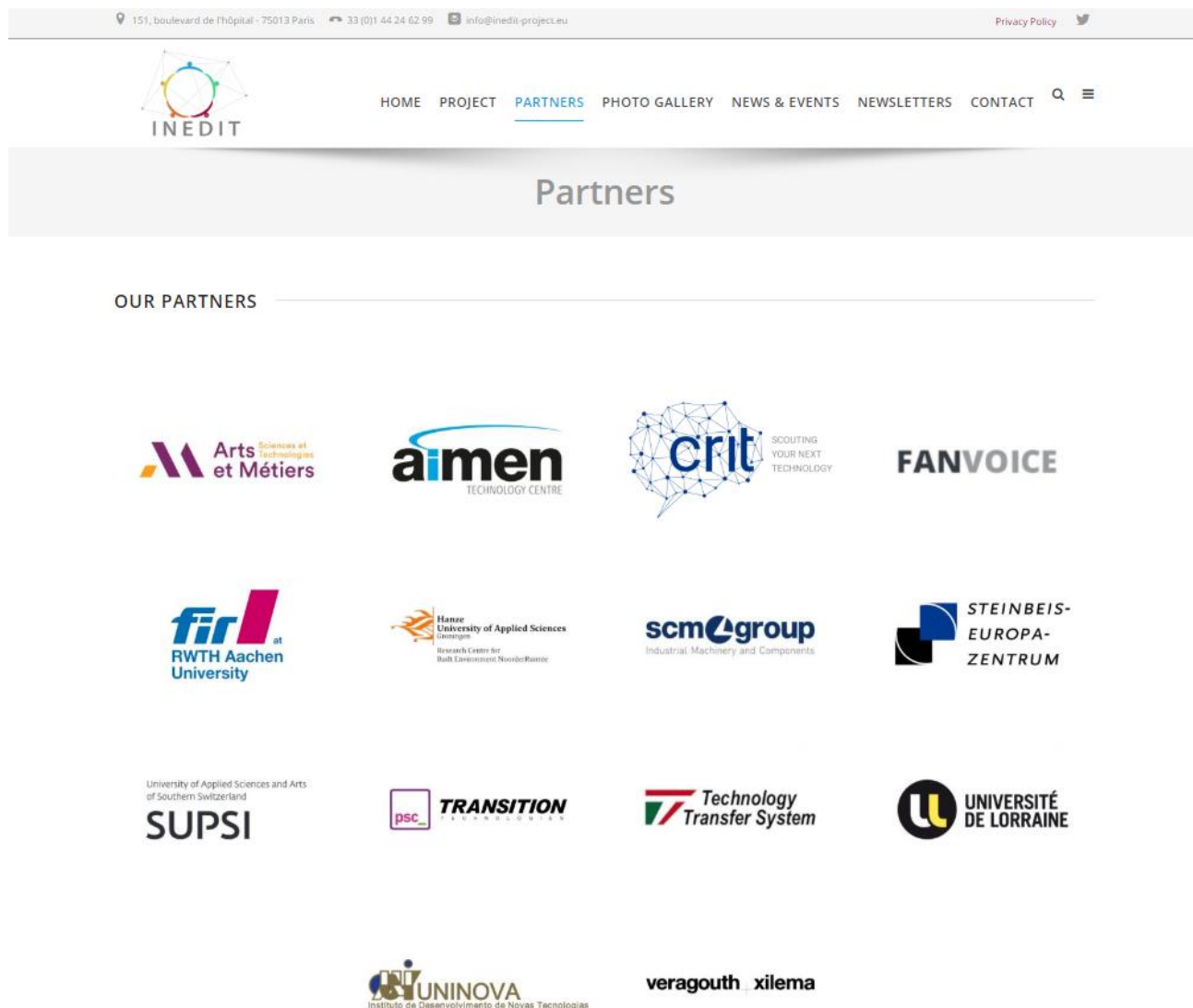


Figure 14: Partners Page

When clicking on the logo of each partner, a pop-up window appears showing the logo, a short description of the partner and a link to the website of the organization.

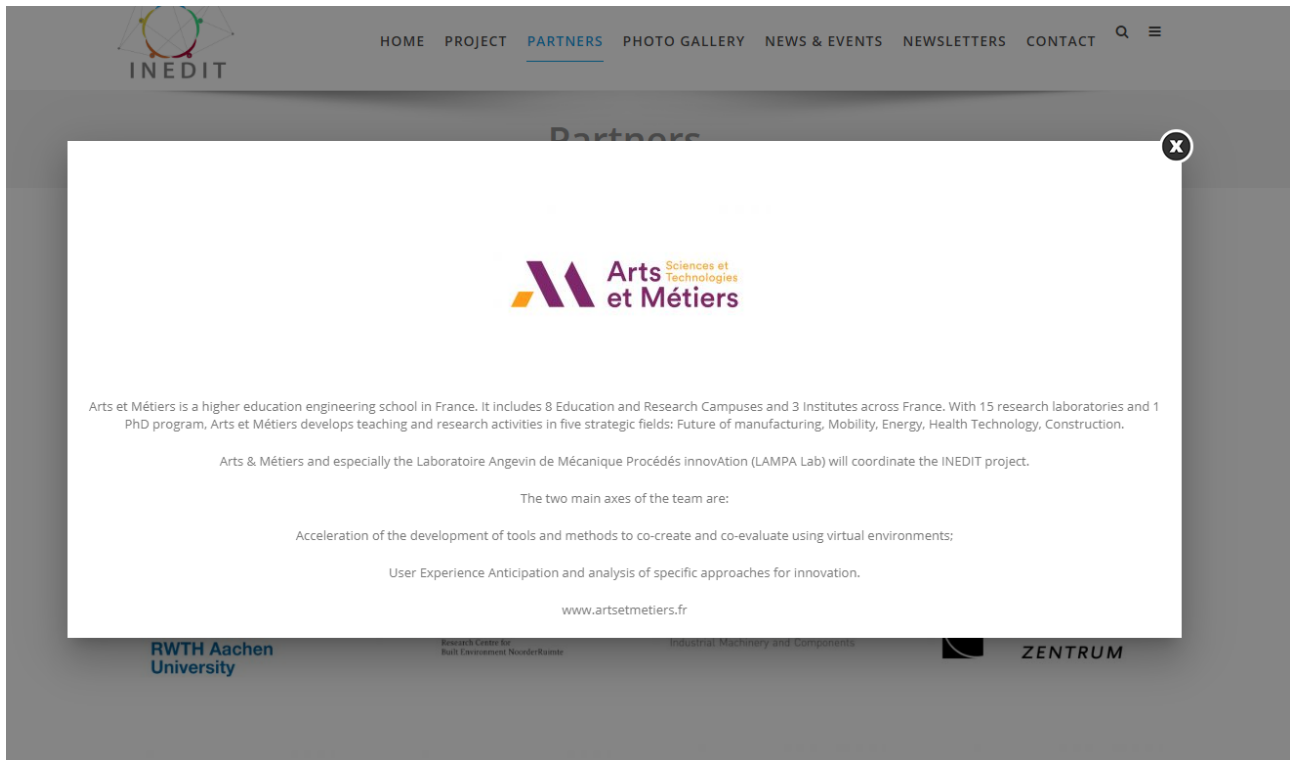
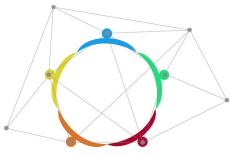
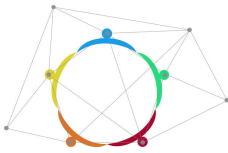



Figure 15: Partners Pop-up Window



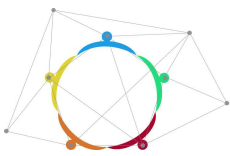

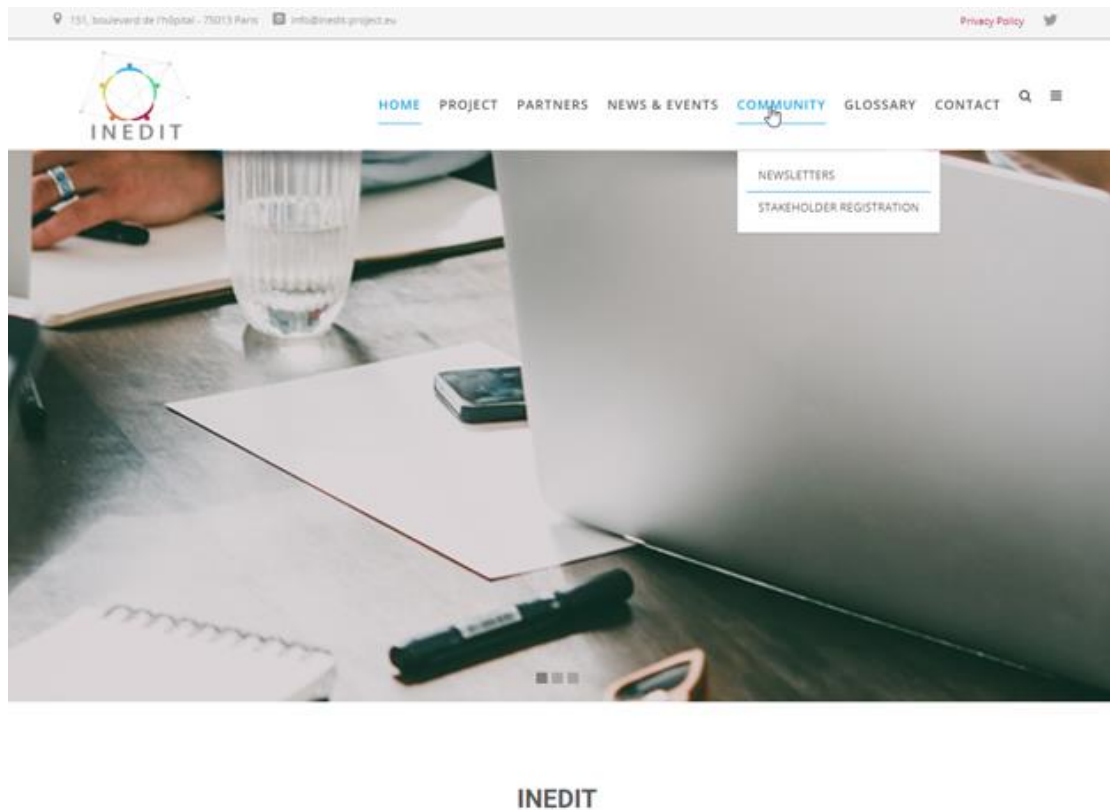


Figure 17: INEDIT Community area

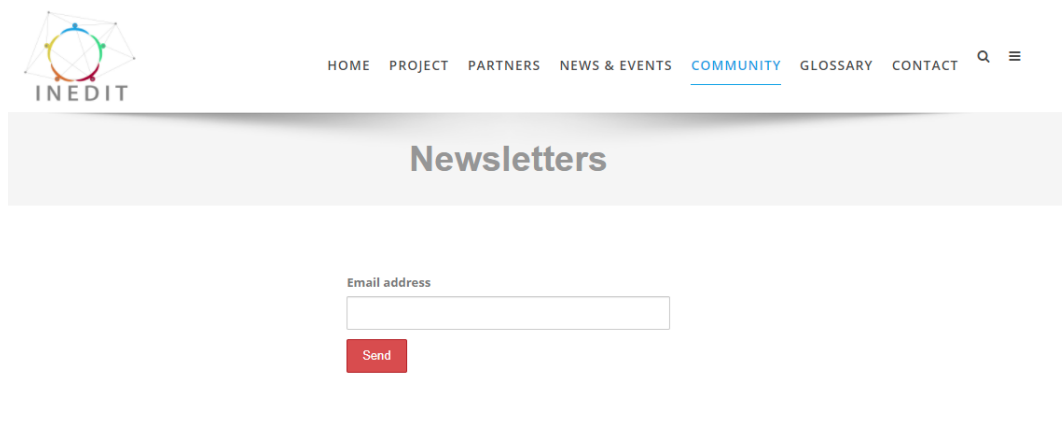
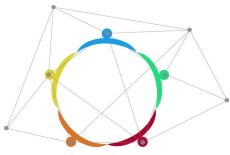


Figure 18: Newsletter subscription bottom

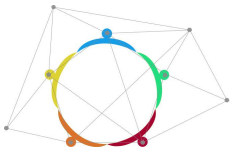
Figure 19: INEDIT Newsletter releases buttons

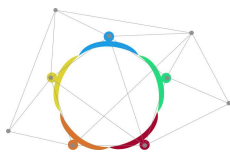

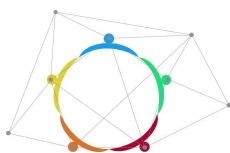
